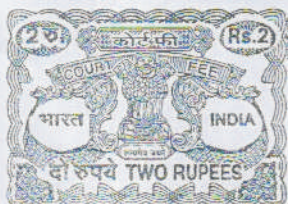

MEMORANDUM AND ARTICLES OF THE SOCIETY AND GENERAL RULES

1. *Name* : The name of the Society shall be the "Orissa-State Ophthalmological Society" (hereinafter called "Society").

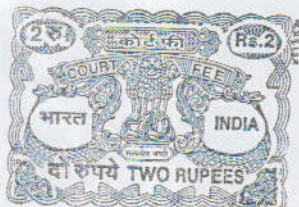
2. The headquarters of the Society shall be located at Cuttack.

3. *Aims and Objects* :

- (i) To cultivate and promote ophthalmic and allied medical sciences in all different branches including improvement of public health and medical education in Orissa from the ophthalmic point of view.
- (ii) To make the people conscious and advise them about preservation of sight.
- (iii) To foster a feeling of fellowship amongst members.

For the attainment and in furtherance of the above objects, the Society may :—

- (a) hold periodical meetings, conferences and social gatherings of the members of the Society and of the medical profession in general ;



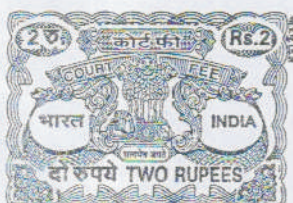
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- (b) arrange quarterly clinical lectures, discussions and demonstrations on any aspect of ophthalmic and allied medical sciences ;
- (c) encourage research in ophthalmic and allied medical sciences ;
- (d) conduct an educative campaign among the masses of Orissa in the matter of public health from the ophthalmic point of view by co-operating if necessary with different public bodies working with the same object ;
- (e) publish, distribute or otherwise circulate records, transactions and proceedings of the various meetings and conferences of the Society to its members in such manners as may be determined from time to time ;
- (f) raise money in such manners as the Society may think fit and collect subscriptions for the purposes of the Society ;
- (g) carry out all such other things as are cognate to the object of the Society or are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.
- (h) do whenever it shall appear to the Executive Committee that it is advisable, to alter, extend or abridge the objects and purposes already declared to or for other purposes within the meaning of original Constitution and the provisions of Act 21 of 1860 or to amalgamate the Society either wholly or partly with any other institute, society or association having altogether or its part objects similar to those of the Society, the Executive Com-



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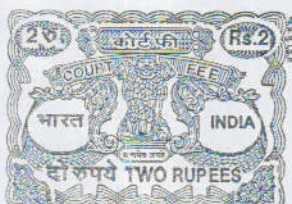
mittee may submit the proposition to the members at a general meeting.

Provided that no such proposition should be carried into effect unless it shall have been agreed to by the votes of the majority members then eligible to vote and unless notice of it shall have been given to all members of the society.

4. *Constitution* : The Society shall consist of :

- (a) *Honorary Members* : Eminent members of the medical profession or persons of high scientific or literary attainment or persons whose association with the Society may seem desirable may be elected as honorary members by the Executive Committee subject to the approval of the general body. They shall not however, be entitled to hold office or to vote ;
- (b) *Ordinary Members* : Any registered medical practitioner interested in Ophthalmology shall be eligible as ordinary member.
- (c) *Associate Members* : All registered medical practitioners interested in Ophthalmology shall be eligible to be associate members. The associate member will enjoy all the privileges of ordinary members other than that of voting.
- (d) *Life Members* : Ordinary members on paying a total sum of Rs. 100/- at one time may, if they so desire, become life members.

5. *Register* : There shall be a register of all members of the Society with particulars.



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Membership and its Privileges

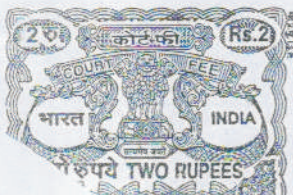
6. The name of all eligible new members shall be recommended by two members before they are approved and admitted as members by the Executive Committee.

7. All ordinary members of the Society shall have the right to attend and take part in all general meetings, conferences, lectures, discussions and demonstrations organised by the Society, to vote on all resolutions according to the bye-laws framed for the purpose, to receive copies of all proceedings and publications of the Society free, or at such rate as the Executive Committee may fix from time to time.

Resignation and Removal of Members

8. A member may at any time resign his membership of the society by giving one month's notice in writing to the Secretary of his intention to do so on paying all money due with him of the Society. If the subscription is not paid by the end of the current financial year all the privileges of membership will automatically cease after serving three months notice.

9. If the conduct of any member shall be deemed by the Executive Committee as prejudicial to the interest of the Society or calculate to bring the ophthalmologists into disrepute, he may be requested by the Committee to resign from the Society. In the event of the said member refusing to do so, his name may be removed from the Register provided that two-thirds of the members present



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at a general meeting called for the purpose, record their votes for this removal.

Subscription

10.(a) The subscription for ordinary membership shall be Rs. 10/- per year (July-June) payable in advance.

(b) The subscription for associate membership shall be Rs. 6.00 per year (July-June) payable in advance.

Executive Committee

11. The general management of the Society shall be vested in an Executive Committee.

The Executive Committee, shall be composed of eleven members.

1. (a) President—1 (one)
- (b) Vice-President—1 (one)
- (c) Honorary Secretary—1 (one)
- (d) Jt. Hon. Secretary—1 (one)
- (e) Hony. Treasurer—1 (one)
2. Members—6 (six)

Election of Office-Bearers and Committee

12. The election of office-bearers and members of the executive committee (also called the committee) shall be held by means of vote after the names are duly proposed and seconded at the annual general body meeting. The mode of election will be at the discretion of the President.



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13. The Executive Committee shall have power to fill vacancies occurring in their number during the term of their office.

Functions and Powers of the Committee

14. The Executive Committee shall direct and regulate the general affairs of the Society and shall, subject to confirmation at a general body meeting, have power to frame rules and bye-laws for the conduct of business at meetings and conferences of the Society.

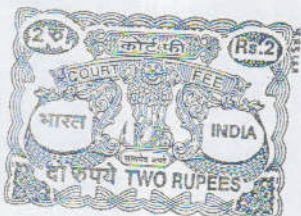
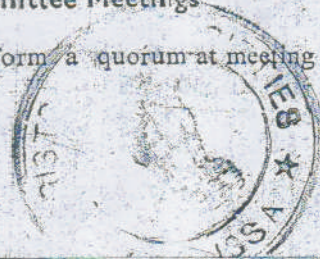
15. The Committee shall ordinarily function for one year or until the next Committee is duly formed.

Executive Committee Meetings

16. The Committee shall ordinarily meet once every quarter. The Secretary shall call ordinary meetings of the Committee in consultation with the President. The President may, whenever he thinks necessary, call a special meeting of the Committee. The Secretary shall, on receiving a requisition signed by four or more members of the Committee call a special meeting of the Committee. The notice of a meeting of the Committee shall be sent to each member of the Committee at least 3 days before the meeting. In requisition meeting only the specific points should be considered.

Quorum of Committee Meetings

17. Five members shall form a quorum at meeting of the Committee.



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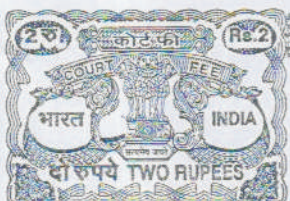
Duties of Office-Bearers

18. The President shall preside at all meetings and shall regulate the proceedings of the meetings and conferences. He shall, besides his ordinary vote, have a casting vote in case of equality. In his absence, the Vice-President shall officiate for him, failing which a member elected at the meeting shall perform his duties.

19. The Secretary shall be in charge of the office, conduct all correspondences, organise and convene meetings, conferences, lectures and demonstrations and keep proceedings thereof.

20. The Treasurer shall receive all money and deposit them in a bank approved by the Committee to the credit of an account kept in the name of the Society. All payments sanctioned by the Committee shall ordinarily be made by cheques signed by him and by one of the Secretaries who may be so empowered by the Committee. He shall keep an account of all receipts and payments. He shall present a half-yearly statement of account to the Committee.

A statement of income and expenditure for the previous financial year ending on 30th April shall be prepared by him and submitted to the auditor appointed by the general body. After the statement of accounts is duly passed by the auditors it shall be presented along with the budget estimate prepared by the Treasurer in consultation with the Secretary at the annual general meeting.



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General Body Meeting

21. *Annual General Meeting* : An annual general meeting shall be held once every year at such time and place as the Committee may determine.

The business to be transacted at the Annual General Meeting shall be :

- (a) to receive and adopt the annual report of the Committee for the past year ;
- (b) to receive and adopt the audited accounts for the past year ;
- (c) to pass the provisional budget for the current year ;
- (d) to elect the office-bearers and the members of the Executive Committee for the current year ;
- (e) to amend or repeal any existing rule.
- (f) to transact such other business as may be brought up at any general meeting with the permission of the President.

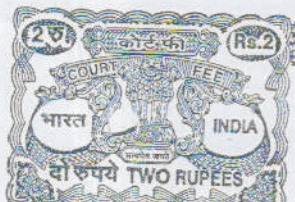
22. *Notice of General Body Meeting* :

Notice of all general body meeting shall be issued to all members as to reach them at least 10 days before the date of meeting. ★

23. *Quorum of General Body Meeting* :

1/3rd members shall form a quorum at a general body meeting.

Audit - The funds of the Society shall be audited by a qualified auditor or a government auditor annually.

Dissolution - Upon dissolution of the Society its assets will be handed over to a similar registered Society after meeting all its debts and liabilities.

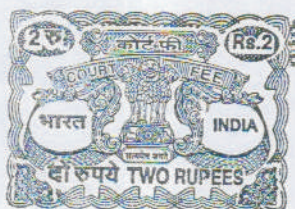
